Kidderminster Studio Parking Guide

Studio Address: Chloe May's Dance Academy, 18-19 Worcester Street, Kidderminster Town Centre, DY10 1ED

Free On-Street Parking:

On-street parking has no time restrictions after 6.30pm!

Up to 30 minutes drop-off bays on Worcester Street where the studio is located.

Up to 1 hour stays round the corner opposite Cue and Brew on Prospect Hill (adjacent to the Bromsgrove Street car park) and on Bromsgrove Street behind the carpark (see map).

Lots of 30min and 1hr bays are also available on other nearby streets.

Car Parks:

The nearest car parks to the studio are Bromsgrove Street, Prospect Hill, Batemans Yard and the NCP Swan Centre carparks all of which are a couple of minutes walk to the studio.

Prospect Hill Car Park (adjacent to Bromsgrove Street Car Park) DY10 1PA

Opening Times: 24/7 parking

30 mins 50p, 1hr £1, 2hrs £1.20, 3hrs £1.50

Bromsgrove Street Car Park: Bromsgrove Street, DY10 1PF

Opening Times: 24/7 parking

Parking Charges:

30 minutes 70p, 1 hr £1.20, 2 hrs £2.30, 3 hours £3.50

6pm-8am charge: £2.00

Using the MiPermit app means motorists do not need change to buy a ticket and can also extend

the parking time without having to return to their vehicle.

There is no top-up fee when someone wants to pay for extra time. Parking can be paid for up to 7

days in advance.

NCP Swan Centre Car Park: Blackwell Street, DY10 2DP

Opening Times: Monday-Saturday 7am-7pm, Sunday: 8.30am-4.30pm

Parking Charges: 1 hr 95p, 2 hrs £1.90, 3 hours £2.85

If you pay via the ParkPass app, this discounts the Swan Centre parking costs to the

following rates: - 1hr 45p, 2hrs 90p, 3hrs £1.35

Morrisons Car Park: Green Street, DY10 1AZ

Opening Times: Monday-Saturday 6am-11pm, Sunday 10am-5pm

This is a 5 minute walk to the studio, but you can park here for up to 2 hours for free.

Batemans Yard Car Park: New Street, DY10 1AR

1 hr free parking Monday - Friday 8.30am-6pm (£2 after 6pm)

Other nearby car parks include Kidderminster College and Aldi Car Parks - 3-4 minute walks to the studio with the same/similar charges to the Bromsgrove Street car park.

We suggest leaving extra time if possible to attend your first couple of classes at the studio so that you can familiarise yourself with which parking/drop-off works best for you/or try different options.
